This course provides an introduction to bookkeeping and accrual accounting, and the application of accounting principles in various legal contexts. Among the topics covered are the preparation and analysis of financial statements, the development of Generally Accepted Accounting Principles, the responsibilities and potential liabilities of auditors, the regulation of dividends and other distributions under state corporations acts, and the financial disclosure requirements of the federal securities laws.
