The Small Business Clinic ("SBC") replicates the environment of a small law firm. The students enrolled in the SBC represent small companies and entrepreneurs who need legal assistance in forming and operation their businesses. Each student assists several clients during the course of the semester, under the supervision of an attorney who is a member of the SBC faculty. The SBC includes a weekly seminar that offers instruction in substantive law, ethical issues and practical lawyering, with an emphasis on the skills required in drafting documents, interviewing and counseling clients, and representing clients in organizational and contractual matters. All the work done in the SBC is transactional in nature.
